



COVID-19 RULES & REGULATIONS

OPERATING HOURS

Weekdays 3pm - midnight
Friday & Saturday 1pm - midnight

RESERVATIONS

- Only reservations are permitted and must be booked in advance.
 - Guests will be permitted to a maximum stay of 2 hours.
 - Maximum of 4 guests per reservation.
- In order to be granted a reservation, guests are permitted to consume food & beverages. Alcoholic beverages cannot be consumed without the purchase of food.

ENTRANCE GUIDELINES

- Minimum age of entry is 21 years old and above, children will not be permitted entrance.
- Must adhere to social distancing guidelines when entering Mulberry Tavern and maintain 2 metre distancing from other guests.
- Guests must show Vaccinated Green Ehteraz upon entrance in order to dine indoors and Green Ehteraz status to dine outdoor on the terrace & temperature checks are in place at all times.
- Guest details will be recorded at entrance including time of visit, temperature and contact number, for your own safety.
- Hands must be sanitised when entering, guests are advised to bring own hand sanitiser where possible.
 - Guests must remain in their designated seating area and are not permitted to sit at any other guests table during their time in the outlet.
 - The management reserves the right to amend the Door Policy and / or to refuse admission to any person if it is deemed necessary

DRESS CODE

- Face masks must be worn when entering and when guests are not seated at their table.
- The dress-code for Mulberry Tavern is smart casual, permitting guests in sports attire and trainers.
 - Caps or gym attire will not be allowed entrance to Mulberry Tavern.
- Guests dressed in local attire or head scarves will not be permitted to enter Mulberry Tavern.

CCTV & PHOTOGRAPHY

- For safety and security reasons, CCTV is in operation at all times.
- For promotional use, photography and social media coverage will be captured throughout Mulberry Tavern.
